

# A message from Herbert N. Johnson Jr.

(Taken from the Bethany Beacon, July 1987)

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

There is a story told about a Vermonter who journeyed to the Maine coast. One day he took a walk along a high point of land and looked down at the crashing tide and breakers some 200 feet below. Unfortunately, he got to close too the edge and the ground under his feet gave way. Quickly he turned and grabbed ahold of same scruffy shrubbery, hanging on for dear life because his whole body was now dangling in space over the edge of the precipice. He could feel the shrubbery begin to loosen and he could see out of the corner of his eye the ocean below, smashing against the rocks. With fear and trembling in big voice he cried out, "Is theyah any buddy else up theyah that can help?"

Suddenly, he heard a deep voice say, "This is the Lord speaking. You've got to have faith. Let go of the shrubbery with both of your hands, and you will be safe." The Vermonter thought a moment and then he shouted out, "Is theyah any buddy else up theyah that can help?"

How easy it is for us to say to another person, "You've got to have faith." Yet we don't tell them what faith is, or how it can be attained.

We live in a farming community. Each fall, we who are gardeners and those who are farmers, prepare the fields in the faith that there will be winter and summer next year. The fields are plowed and fertilized before the winter snows come. The farmers can't prove that spring will come but they have faith that it will.

Yet faith is more than this, It is a belief in the existence of God, using the classical arguments, such as the teleological, ontological or cosmological, has not made one single convert that I know of. Likewise, I have never met anyone who has been able to prove to me that God doesn't exist.

In defining faith, there is probably no better answer than the one given in the letter to the Hebrews. "Faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen,"

God has given us minds and reason and he expects us to use these attributes in the development of our faith. Faith deals with matters which have not been proved or perhaps cannot be proved. It is the assurance of things hoped for, It is the conviction of things not seen. If we can prove it, then it is not faith but knowledge and fact. We in essence say, "I know it." When it is faith we say, "I believe it."






